Fewer Noble firs and Nordmann firs are available in the area this year, but we expect to have some Noble firs and possibly some Nordmanns. We should have plenty of Grand firs and Douglas Firs in a variety of sizes, including table-top. We also will have fresh evergreen wreaths for sale.
